**Subject:** Qur'an & Tajweed

**Text Used:** *JMC Basic Rules of Tajweed*

**Objective:** To acquire an understanding of the primary rules of Tajweed and apply it while reciting the Qur'an.

**Subject:** Qur'an Memorization (29<sup>th</sup> & 30<sup>th</sup> Juz)

**Objective:** To memorize the 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> parts of the Qur'an.

**Subject:** Arabic Writing Practice

**Text Used:** *Arabiyyah Baina Yadaik | Book 1, Volume 1 & 2*

**Objective:** To practice writing individual letters, joint letters, vocabulary words, and sentences.

**Subject:** Sarf (Arabic Morphology)

**Text Used:** *Morphology Made Easy*

**Objective:** To introduce and analyze linguistic word (nouns and verbs) patterns.

**Subject:** Nahw (Arabic Grammar)

**Text Used:** *Tasheel an-Nahw*

**Objective:** To identify and analyze nouns/verbs/particles, and to analyze basic sentence structures with their translations.

**Subject:** Arabic Comprehension

**Text Used:** *Duroos-al-Lughat-al-Arabiyyah | Book 1 & 2*

**Objective:** To reinforce grammar and morphology concepts, increase the students' vocabulary, and provide a firm grasp of phraseology that is common to both spoken and written speech.

**Subject:** Arabic Conversation

**Text Used:** *Arabiyyah Baina Yadaik | Book 1, Volume 1 & 2*

**Objective:** To develop conversational skills, and to introduce varied contemporary vocabulary and phraseology.

**Subject:** Aqeedah (Islamic Theology)

**Text Used:** *Aqeedah at-Tahawiyyah*

**Objective:** To provide students with a firm grasp of that which is necessary for Muslims to believe, and to analyze heretical/deviated beliefs to refute their arguments.

**Subject:** Introduction to Fiqh (Islamic Jurisprudence)

**Text Used:** *Ascent to Felicity*

**Objective:** To introduce students to the development of Fiqh, the Four Schools of Islamic Jurisprudence, the reasons for differences of opinions, and understand the concepts of Taqleed/Ijtihad. Students will then cover a comprehensive primer in jurisprudence, learning the rulings behind the Five Pillars of Islam and more.

**Subject:** Seerah (Biography of the Prophet ﷺ)

**Text Used:** *Mercy to the World*

**Objective:** To cover the events which occurred in the life of the Prophet ﷺ, from his birth to the end of his life, with the purpose of providing insight into his mannerisms, ethics, and teachings.

**Subject:** Hadith (Prophetic Traditions)

**Text Used:** *JMC 40 Hadith & Riyad as-Saliheen*

**Objective:** To start with the memorization and study of 40 hadith, thereafter begin the study/memorization of selected hadith from the timeless collection of Imam An-Nawawi, *Riyad as-Saliheen*.

**Subject:** Tafseer (Qur'anic Exegesis)

**Objective:** To introduce students to the meanings of the 29th & 30th parts of the Qur'an.

**Subject:** Daily Du'aa (Supplications)

**Text Used:** *JMC Du'aa Book*

**Objective:** To memorize daily supplications from the traditions of the Prophet ﷺ.

**Subject:** Tazkiyat an-Nafs (Purification of the Heart)

**Text Used:** *Ayyuhal Walad & Bidayatul Hidayah*

**Objective:** To understand diseases of the heart, plots of Shaytaan, and practical tools to purify the heart in order to build a stronger relationship with Allah ﷻ.
